1. Make sure you have a will and it is up to date! If you have minor children, make sure it indicates who you would like to have raise them in the event you and your spouse both perish unexpectedly.

2. It is necessary to have both a medical Power of Attorney and a durable Power of Attorney. Consult an attorney on this matter. LegalZoom is also a good, cheaper resource.

3. Have all your legal documents in one place. Consider purchasing a fire-proof safe for this purpose. There are small document size safes available. If you do not wish to have a safe, consider storing, at least copies, of these documents away from your home.

4. Discuss your legal matters with the one(s) you have designated as your executor or executrix in your will. A conversation now will save headaches and possible legal fees to sort it out.

5. Preplan your funeral service. There are funeral planning guides for you to use below the church mailboxes.
