Dear Congregation,

The first tweet on my Twitter account this morning (Tuesday) was from Ken Byler of Souderton, PA. It read, "The very best teams are taking advantage of today's volatile circumstances to capture the essence of what is working while learning and adapting from every obstacle or challenge."

By Mr. Byler's definition, **SCMC** has a "best team" in our Church Council! Last night (Monday), Church Council wrestled with and wept over how the COVID-19 pandemic has affected life in general, but more specifically, SCMC fellowship, congregational unity, and worship gatherings. We are extremely concerned about how the issue of face masks has kept some from meeting in person for worship. If there ever has been a time to meet together for encouragement, it is now.

Coming out of our Council meeting, we will be experimenting* with the following:

- August 30 and September 13 Sunday mornings, the use of face masks will not be required. However, the wearing of face masks is encouraged. There will also be designated seating for "high-risk" individuals/families who desire to worship weekly.
- September 6 and 20 Sunday mornings, the wearing of face masks will be required just as we have been doing for weeks.
- September 27 Sunday morning will be our Baptism/Church Membership. Lord willing and weather permitting, this will be an outdoor service. More details will be given as the date gets closer.

*Viewing this as an experiment, gives us the freedom to fail, learn from what has been tried, and make changes in the future to best draw us together.

None of us have ever been confronted with such uncertainty as we are now, and we, as SCMC leadership, covet your prayers and need your patience as we figure out what brings us together as the body of Christ.
