Forty-nine staples later in the recovery room finds a better result, then to ICU on 5th floor of St. Luke's Hospital to begin a 10-day stay for recovery. 'God's Healing" and medical science administered by a very caring and professional staff sped the process. Visits by MJ, family and friends were appreciated.
