## Steel City Mennonite Church Mid-Week Connection September 27, 2017

**This Sunday, October 1**, we will observe "**World Communion Sunday**". On the first Sunday of October, Christian communities of faith gather to remember the ordinance of Communion. We will join with many around the globe during our time of Communion.

**A word about the observance of Communion**. Jesus Himself instituted what we refer to as Communion at the Last Supper. In the upper room where Jesus and His disciples had gathered to observe the Passover, Jesus took the bread, blessed it, broke it and then gave to His disciples saying, "Take and eat, this is my body". Likewise, He did the same with the wine, stating it was the blood of the new covenant. (Matthew 26:26-29)

Years later, the Apostle Paul reminds the Corinthian church to reflect on the seriousness of sharing in the bread and cup of the Lord's Supper (Communion). The Corinthians were making a mockery of the elements treating it more like a party buffet than a reminder of Jesus's death. Paul warns them about partaking the bread and cup in a manner unworthy or unfitting and in doing so one profanes the body of Jesus. Paul goes further as he states, partaking of the bread and cup without examining one's spiritual life calls judgement upon them. (I Corinthians 11:17f)

The partaking of Communion is a serious matter. In preparation for this Sunday's sharing of the bread and the cup, you are asked to examine your spiritual life. Do an accounting: Where have you grieved the heart of God? Is there something God is asking of you but you are refusing? Is Jesus truly your Lord?

If we are at peace with God through Jesus Christ, we ought to be at peace with each other. Yet in our humanness we can hold on to offenses (real or perceived). Is there someone you need to forgive? Do you need to reconcile with someone?

On Sunday, no one is going to ask you point blank about your peace with God and each other or even your readiness to share in Communion. This is between you and God. But I trust you will have reflected on the seriousness of Communion. With much love, PD.

His eyesight is weakened to the point that people must be very close in proximity to him for Bob to recognize the person. Pastor Bob is so concerned that people will misunderstand his lack of eyesight for being slighted by him. It is this sensitive spirit which has endeared Bob to many of us. We can also help him by telling Bob who we are when we approach him. (PD)
