Shared by Scott Richards, Chair of Church Council and of the Congregation, on Sunday, September 28, 2014 <u>SCMC - STRETCH GIVING</u>

Church Council and Finance Commission have met in regards to our growing church budget deficit. Our YTD budget has a deficit of over **\$30,000 dollars**. Our church leaders are asking if you can unite and partner with us as we work together to bring our budget back to even, to continue our daily church operations while growing His Kingdom.

This church has a beautiful new facility with a wide variety of programs & events, which allows each one of us to participate and grow in His Word. Around 15 years ago, this very church went out on faith and was stretched financially and this church family prayed and was blessed. We paid off our debt and doubled our weekly Sunday attendance from an average of 80 people on a Sunday to an average of 160+ people a Sunday.

I am standing before you today, as the head of Church Council, asking if you are willing to walk in faith and unite with this great church. Asking if each of you are willing to be **STRETCHED** in your giving & support of this church.

We see multiple times throughout scripture when God's people have given a tithe or more of what they earn back to him in gratitude for his love and are blessed in multiple ways.

We read in <u>2 Corinthians 9:6-8</u>: "Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work."

We also read in <u>Malachi 3:10</u>: "Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this," says the Lord Almighty, "and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it."
