Recently, Pastor David heard a podcast that gave some sobering statistics. In the year 2000, a survey was done of self-professing Christians who attended weekly worship services, the average was people attended worship services 3.6 Sundays or weekends a month. In 2018, the survey was repeated again by self-professing Christians, who by their own admission state that they attend worship services on a weekend. This time, the findings revealed that people are attending worship services 1.6 times a month on average. This decline is attributed to people having more demands on their schedule and/or their children involved in weekend activities. Think about the priority of gathered worship for you and your family. Is gathering for worship a priority? Why or why not?
