Our **Bible Reading Program for 2017** will be called, Let's Read the Bible Together. January is part 1 of a 12-part series; this plan leads communities through the whole Bible together in 365 days. The plan can be followed either by reading the text listed in the worship folder or by using the Bible app, "You Version".
