For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes." (ESV)

Today, the **sacrament of Communion** will be shared among us. In preparation to receive the bread and the cup, Pastor David will be speaking on the "**Power of Communion**" based on the scripture text of **1 Corinthians 11:23-26**.

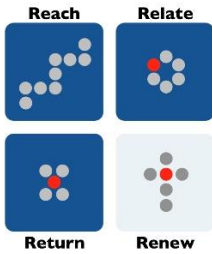
