If you have not already done so by e-mail, please check out the **Church Directory** on the table in the foyer and make any changes if necessary, or initial if correct. Thank you!



Ministry Opportunities & Events

This Friday, January 11, many of our SCMC family will answer the call to participate in 21 Days of Prayer and Fasting. Prayer, fasting and giving are each an assumption Jesus made about His followers. (Matthew 6) The most common fast is the Daniel fast. The Daniel fast is limiting one's food intake to fruits, vegetables and fruit juices. Some further include in that list legumes and nuts. One of the best presentations of fasting guidelines comes from the International House of Prayer - Kansas City. There are copies of these guidelines in the fover. Before you begin your fast, it is good to have a written prayer and fasting focus. In other words, why are you fasting? You may need a miracle. You may be healing of a relationship. You may need a financial breakthrough. Your focus may be completely different. Write these down. Look for God to work. Write those down as promises of a future fulfillment. It would be good to keep a prayer and fasting journal. Great things are going to happen!
