Ministry Opportunities & Events

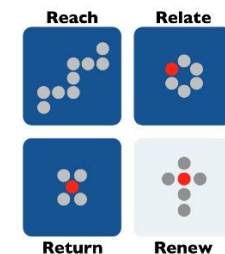

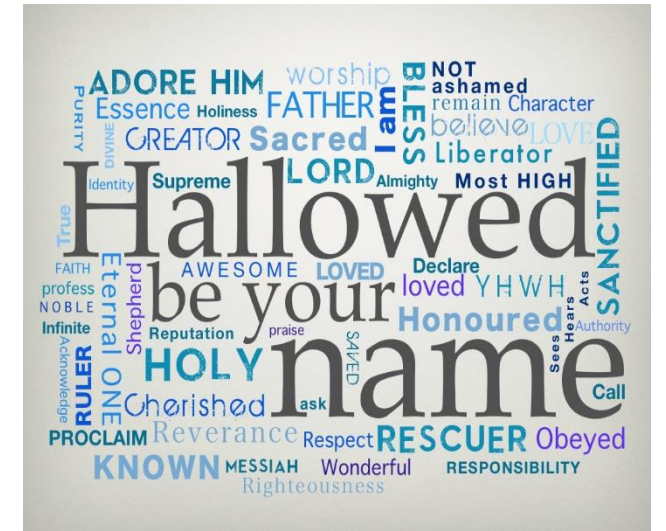
