The **Outreach Commission** will be meeting on Monday, September 30 at 7:00 p.m.

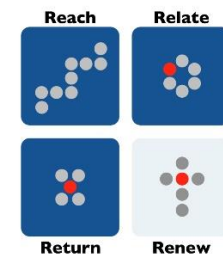
There will be a **Zion Choral Concert** at SCMC on Sunday, October 20 at 3:00 p.m. Mark your calendars now and plan to invite friends!
